Town of Poetry last day to VOTE IS MAY 6TH!

Synopsis of April 27th Executive & Special Meeting. {Regular meeting was postponed to this date.}

• Reports:

Mayor read results of Midyear Budget vs. Actual: The town is fiscally very healthy in that revenues are 10.5 % OVER what was projected and is currently 13% UNDER on projected expenses. The total budget for the year is \$134,397.67.

Secretary read Elections and Secretary reports.

CM Vinson reported that the Postmaster state the town has achieved Preferred Last Line as "Poetry" coming soon.

CM Vinson also read the <u>Comptrollers letter</u> that revenues from Sales & Use tax will be arriving the second Friday of each month beginning in June.

- After holding a 30-minute executive session, the council decided to move both secretaries to w-2 position which will require Medicare and Social Security taxes to be paid.
- <u>Discussed</u> obtaining Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for prospective engineers for the town.
- <u>Discussed</u> the request for Voluntary Annexation of a portion of property from citizens Lori & Andy Bass.
- <u>Discussed</u> the Ordinance inhibiting future councils from voting in an Ad Valorem Tax (Property Tax).

- Voted to approve for renewal the Interlocal Renewal for Agreement for the next two years with Kaufman County for road maintenance.
- Voted to pay March legal bill of \$195.
- Voted to pay TML annual membership fee of \$788
- Approved Project K-04 with Kaufman County to work on roads CR 247, CR 249, Gate Lane, Four Post Lane and Green Meadows Lane for \$3280.
- Approved Project H-06 for Hunt County to work on roads CR 2458 and CR 2432 for \$1000.
- Approved purchase of a weatherproof outdoor bulletin board in place of the non-weatherproof outdoor bulletin board voted on last month.
- Voted to approve the new septic quote by
 Vicars Septic Service. [Owing to unforeseen
 circumstances, he was unable to follow
 through with his previous quote]. Sheri Vinson
 pledged \$500 for the septic installation which
 makes the town paying \$2500 total with the
 prior donations of \$4000.
