

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-11-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 SPECIAL ELECTION HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE TOWN THE BALLOT PROPOSITION OF WHETHER TO ADOPT THE LEVY OF A SALES AND USE TAX FOR STREET MAINTENANCE AT A RATE OF TWO PERCENT (2%) TO PROVIDE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS; PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF PREMISES; PROVIDING CONFIRMATION OF VOTE TABULATION AND CANVASS; PROVIDING FOR ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT; PROVIDING NOTICE, OPEN MEETINGS, AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council (the "Town Council") of the Town of Poetry, Texas (the "Town") on August 5th, ordered that a Special Election be held within the Town on November 2, 2021, (the "Special Election"), for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the Town the ballot proposition of whether to adopt the levy of a sales and use tax for street maintenance at a rate of two percent (2%) to provide for maintenance and repair of municipal streets (the "Proposition"); and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2021, the Special Election was held in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and the Election Code for the purpose of submitting the Proposition to the qualified voters of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Election Code requires that the governing body of the Town of Poetry, Texas canvass all elections; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council may not convene to canvass the election until the early voting ballot board has convened and counted all provisional and overseas ballots pursuant to Section 67.003 of the Election Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 321.405 of the Tax Code, the Town Council is required to meet no later than the 10th day after the date of the Special Election to canvass election results that approve of the adoption, change in rate, or abolition of a tax authorized under Chapter 321 of the Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the official returns of the election on the Proposition, including returns of early voting ballots cast, of the presiding judges of the Special Election have been presented and delivered; and the Town Council declares the results of said returns in accordance with the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Premises. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. Confirmation of Vote Tabulation. The Council officially finds and determines that at the Special Election held on November 2, 2021, the following Proposition was submitted to the qualified voters of the Town of Poetry, Texas and the following votes were cast, and that based upon the votes cast, the following Proposition was approved:

SECTION 3. Canvass. The Council finds that said election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with state law, that said election was held in accordance with state law, the results of the election as set forth above are correct, and the canvass of the votes are hereby ratified and approved. Therefore, the Council orders that a local sales and use tax at the rate of two percent for municipal street repair and maintenance is hereby adopted.

SECTION 4. Notice. Upon adoption of this Ordinance, the Town Secretary is directed to immediately give notice of the election results concerning the proposition to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts and any other agency required by law.

SECTION 5. Open Meeting. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Article 551.041, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 6. Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance

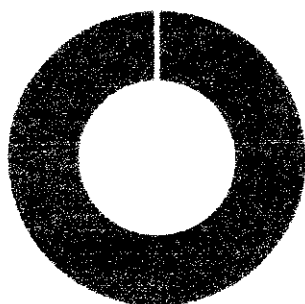


SECTION 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
