

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07-01R

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS DENYING THE AUGUST 1, 2022, EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE PROPOSED CHANGE IN RATES AS SUBMITTED BY ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY, LLC ON OR AROUND MAY 13, 2022; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; REQUIRING THIS RESOLUTION TO BE SENT TO ONCOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on or about May 13, 2022, Oncor Electric Delivery Company ("Oncor"), pursuant to the Public Utility Regulatory Act ("PURA") §§ 33.001 and 36.001, filed with the Town of Poetry (the "Town") a Statement of Intent to increase electric transmission and distribution rates in all cities exercising original jurisdiction within its service area effective August 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, PURA § 33.023 provides that the reasonable costs of services incurred by cities of any rate consultant, accountant, auditor, attorney, or engineer to conduct investigations, present evidence, and advise and represent the governing body, and assist the governing body with litigation in a ratemaking proceeding, are to be reimbursed by the regulated utility; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The above and foregoing premises are found to be true and correct and are incorporated as is set forth fully herein.

SECTION 2. That the August 1, 2022, effective date of the rate request submitted by Oncor on or about May 13, 2022, is hereby denied and disapproved, and Oncor shall continue to provide electric delivery service within the Town of Poetry in accordance with its rate schedules and service regulations in effect within this municipality on August 1, 2022.




SECTION 6. This Resolution is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
