NEW: TRASH CHANGES!

On November 16th, the Poetry Town Council voted to make **Blackjack Disposal** the exclusive polycart and smaller dumpster provider in the town! [CARDS and Titan will not be collecting polycarts and small dumpsters after December 31, 2023. The price for first polycart is \$27.50 + tax. Each additional polycart is \$12. You can call them at **972-427-7770** for more information or email poetry @blackjackdisposal.com. Roll-offs can still be provided by those **only** vendors who are approved in town. Currently, Blackjack, CARDS, and Texas Contractors Roll-offs are approved vendors in town. There is a \$500 per incident fine for a non-approved vendor.

Synopsis of November 2nd Workshop, Workshop & Special Meeting at Poetry Town Hall.

<u>6:30 pm Workshop Meeting:</u> Council members listened to citizens and discussed with attorney Berman a proposed zoning ordinance.

7:30 Special Meeting:

- <u>**Denied**</u> release from ETJ petition from Bishop Airfield Ranch, LLC.
- **<u>Approved</u>** release from ETJ petition by Emard.
- **<u>Approved</u>** release from ETJ petition by Bryant.
- <u>Approved</u> a \$125 processing fee for any new petitions to account for secretarial and legal time required.
- <u>Approved</u> renewal of M365 Business & Archiving license renewal using a Texas based company if the changeover is not labor intensive.
- <u>Approved</u> \$2600 for closed cell foam for the crawl space in the Town hall building. The meeting adjourned at 9:56 pm.

Synopsis of November 16th Regular Town Council Meeting at Poetry Town Hall.

The mayor announced Town Hall phone number #469-902-7001. The building is open to the public Thursdays 1-5 pm. She gave financial reports.

- Voted to pay legal bill of \$1706.25
- <u>Voted</u> to have an exclusive trash vendor for polycarts and small dumpsters. Voted for non-exclusive roll-offs.
- <u>Voted to choose Blackjack Disposal to begin</u> <u>exclusive service in Poetry Jan. 2nd. 2024.</u>
- **Formed** a subcommittee with CM Anderson, CM White and Mayor Senkevech to fine tune the Trash Collection Ordinance and Franchise Agreements.
- <u>Approved</u> HVAC installation for \$9044.99 and electrical expenses not to exceed the budgeted amount of \$10,500. Approved spending \$1000 for ADA looped railing needed.
- <u>Discussed</u> Town Policy determining removal of dead trees in the town's rights of way versus private property.
- <u>Voted</u> to allow Volunteer Roads team to spend up to \$3000 to repair Green Meadow, Four Post and Gate Lane which Kaufman county has not yet been completed in 7 months since approval.
- <u>Approved</u> Hunt County repairing 12 roads for \$4250.00 for materials costs.
- <u>Discussed</u> Zoning Ordinance with added amendments. Decided to form subgroup with CM Blake and CM White. Meeting adjourned at 9:56 pm.
