E. Consent Agenda

F. Regular Agenda (item sponsor)

1. Discuss and take action as necessary on Ordinance to establish the Poetry Town Council as the Zoning Board of Adjustment (Mayor)

Under Texas Local Government Code Title 7, Subtitle A, Chapter 211, 211.008 (a) "The governing body of a municipality may provide for the appointment of a board of adjustment." 211.008 (g) "The governing body of a Type A general-law municipality by ordinance may grant the members of the governing body the authority to act as the board of adjustment under this chapter." This ordinance does just that.

2. Discuss and take action as necessary on a Zoning Variance Application. (Mayor)

As we get more involved in applying our Zoning ordinance we will need a formal way for citizens to request variances. As part of this we need to collect quite a few pieces of information from the applicant which is the purpose of this document.

3. Discuss and take action as necessary on the Resolution to Deny the Oncor Rate Increase. (Mayor)

In our July 29, 2025 Special Meeting the Council voted to join the Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor. This added our voice to 170 other Texas cities in negotiating with Oncor. The committee has delivered their opinion and it is to "Deny" the rate increase which sends the request back to the Texas Public Utility Commission for final decision. All "Approve" or "Deny" responses are due by October 29, 2025.

4. Discuss and take action as necessary on a Driveway Culvert Ordinance including an Application for a Culvert Permit Form. (Mayor Pro-Tem)

The need for this ordinance was discussed in our September meeting. This is a proposed ordinance and application for culvert permit. For the foreseeable future a member of Council or the Mayor, will serve as the town's representative in determining culvert decisions and inspections.

5. Discuss and take action as necessary on a Resolution to designate the Terrell Tribune as the Town of Poetry official Newspaper. (Mayor)

All towns in Texas must designate an Official Newspaper each year. Texas Local Government Code Title 2, Subtitle D, Chapter 52, Sec.52.004 (a) "As soon as practicable after the beginning of each municipal year, the governing body of the municipality shall contract, as determined by ordinance or resolution, with a public newspaper of the municipality to be the municipality's official newspaper until another newspaper is selected." This ordinance does that for 2025-2026.

6. Discuss and take action as necessary on approving additional funds, \$12,000, to be placed in Escrow with Hunt County to replace under road drainage culverts in 3 different locations in the Town of Poetry. (Mayor)

There are 2-36" culverts under CR2454, 3-30" culverts under CR 2440 and 1-24" culvert under 2466. All of them are rusted through and are collapsing causing the roadway to also collapse. Hunt County has quoted the

total cost of replacing all three locations, charging only for materials at \$11,171.60. Large trees interfering with 2 of these locations have already been removed in preparation for the projects.

Action or responses to your remarks by council members (if not a posted agenda item) are limited to either a statement of fact or recitation of an existing policy or a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a future meeting.

Note: The Town Council reserves the right to meet in Executive Session closed to the public at any time in the course of this meeting to discuss matters listed on the agenda, as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, including Sec. 551.071 (private consultation with the attorney for the Town); Sec. 551.072 (purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property); Sec. 551.074 (personnel or to hear complaints against personnel); Sec. 551.076 (deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices); and Sec. 551.087 (economic development negotiations). Any decision held on such matters will be taken or conducted in Open Session following the conclusion of the Executive Session.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE MEMBERS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL AS MEMBERS OF THE TOWN'S BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, state law authorizes the governing bodies of Type A general-law municipalities to act as a board of adjustment and to exercise the duties and authority granted to boards of adjustment under state law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds and determines that the duly qualified members of the Town Council should serve as a board of adjustment to hear and decide matters delegated to boards of adjustment under state law, and that this designation is in the best interest of the citizens of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the Town Council of the Town of Poetry, Texas be and is hereby designated as the Board of Adjustment of the Town of Poetry, Texas, and shall have and exercise the powers, duties authority of a board of adjustment as allowed or directed by state law.

SECTION 2: That when acting as a board of adjustment, the Council may (1) hear and decide an appeal that alleges error in an order, requirement, decision, or determination made by an administrative official in the enforcement of zoning regulations; (2) hear and decide special exceptions to the terms of a zoning ordinance when an ordinance requires the board to do so; (3) authorize in specific cases a variance from the terms of a zoning ordinance if the variance is not contrary to the public interest and, due to special conditions, a literal enforcement of the ordinance would result in unnecessary hardship, and so that the spirit of the ordinance is observed and substantial justice is done; and (4) hear and decide other matters authorized by ordinance. The meeting, quorum and voting requirements applicable to boards of adjustment shall apply to the

Council when acting as a board of adjustment; provided, however, that the mayor shall not be deemed to be a member of the board and shall have no voting authority.

SECTION 3: That should any word, sentence, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: That all provisions of the ordinances of the Town of Poetry in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the Town of Poetry not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.

The particular physical surroundings, shape or topographical condition of the specific property involved would result in a practical difficulty or unnecessary hardship or inequity upon or for the owner or occupant, as distinguished from a mere inconvenience, if the provisions of the regulations were literally enforced;
- 3. The request for a variance is not based exclusively upon a desire from the owner, occupant, or applicant for increased financial gain from the property, or to reduce an existing financial hardship;
- 4. The granting of the variances will not be materially detrimental or injurious to, or adversely affect the rights of, owners or residents of surrounding properties;
- 5. The proposed variance will not impair an adequate supply of light or air to adjacent property, substantially increase congestion in the public streets, increase the danger of fire, endanger the public safety, substantially diminish or impair property values within the neighborhood, or otherwise be opposed to the general spirit and intent of this Unified Development Code.

Zoning Variance Site Plan Requirements

The following information shall be shown on each site plan (sheet size 8 ½" x 11") submitted to the Town with an application for a Zoning Variance. Drawing must be to scale with a graphic scale and North Arrow. One copy of the site plan shall be submitted initially with the application.

The general information and data listed below may not be applicable to all types of zoning variance. Please refer to the *Town of Poetry Zoning Ordinance*.

- 1. The location of all property lines and lot dimensions.
- 2. The location of all setbacks according to zoning.
- 3. The location of all existing structures with a solid line and proposed structures in a dashed line.
- 4. Include the dimensions of all structures, square footage and separation distances from the
- 5 structures
- 6. The location and label of all adjacent streets, alleys, and access easements, to include known
- 7. utilities easements.
- 8. For signage, provide all details for signs.
- 9. The location of off-street parking areas.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS FINDING THAT ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY LLC'S APPLICATION TO CHANGE RATES WITHIN THE TOWN SHOULD BE DENIED; FINDING THAT THE TOWN'S REASONABLE RATE CASE EXPENSES SHALL BE REIMBURSED BY THE COMPANY; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; REQUIRING NOTICE OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE COMPANY AND LEGAL COUNSEL.

WHEREAS, the Town of Poetry, Texas ("Town") is an electric utility customer of Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC ("Oncor" or "Company"), and a regulatory authority with an interest in the rates and charges of Oncor; and

WHEREAS, the Town is a member of the Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor ("Steering Committee"), a coalition of similarly situated cities served by Oncor that have joined together to efficiently and cost effectively review and respond to electric issues affecting rates charged in Oncor's service area; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 26, 2025, Oncor filed with the Town an application to increase system-wide transmission and distribution rates by about \$834 million or approximately 13% over present revenues. The Company asks the Town to approve an 12.3% increase in residential rates and a 51.0% increase in street lighting rates; and

WHEREAS, the Steering Committee is coordinating its review of Oncor's application and working with the designated attorneys and consultants to resolve issues in the Company's filing; and

WHEREAS, through review of the application, the Steering Committee's consultants determined that Oncor's proposed rates are excessive; and

WHEREAS, the Steering Committee's members and attorneys recommend that members deny the Application; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the rates proposed by Oncor to be recovered through its electric rates charged to customers located within the Town limits, are hereby found to be unreasonable and shall be denied.

- Section 2. That the Company shall continue to charge its existing rates to customers within the Town.
- Section 3. That the Town's reasonable rate case expenses shall be reimbursed in full by Oncor.
- Section 4. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.
- Section 5. That a copy of this Resolution shall be sent to Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC, 1616 Woodall Rodgers Freeway, Dallas, Texas 75202 and to Thomas Brocato, Counsel to the Steering Committee, at Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C., 816 Congress Ave., Suite 1900, Austin, Texas 78701.

DRIVEWAY CULVERTS PROCESSING AND STANDARDS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS, CREATING "DRIVEWAY CULVERTS PROCESSING AND STANDARDS"; ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CULVERTS WITHIN TOWN LIMITS; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town possesses the authority to adopt ordinances necessary to protect the interests and welfare of the Town and its residents pursuant to Section 51.012 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 311 of the Texas Transportation Code grants to a general law municipality the authority to construct and regulate the construction of a culvert within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 217 of the Texas Local Government Code grants authority to the governing body of a municipality to prevent and abate a nuisance located within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, private driveways constructed without a culvert negatively impact the proper flow of water and drainage and lead to flooding of adjacent roadways and private property and can create a nuisance; and

WHEREAS, a property owner is best equipped to construct and perpetually maintain the driveway culvert that serves their own property; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Poetry ("Council") finds that requiring a culvert to be installed in each new driveway constructed within the Town limits best protects the Town's roadways and adjacent private property from flooding and is in service of the health, safety, and wellbeing of the residents of the Town of Poetry; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town and its residents to require installation of a culvert for each new driveway constructed within the Town, and to provide for "Driveway Culverts Processing and Standards" provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POETRY, TEXAS:

SECTION I

The Town's "Driveway Culverts Processing and Standards" provisions are hereby adopted and shall read as follows:

PART 1: PURPOSE

To protect the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Town by ensuring the proper flow of water and drainage and preventing flooding on the Town's streets and right-of-way and adjacent private property, by requiring installation of a culvert in each new driveway constructed in the Town.

PART 2: DEFINITIONS

For purposes of this Ordinance, when not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future tense, words in the plural include the singular, and words in the singular include the plural, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders whenever the sense requires. Words not defined in this part shall be given their common and ordinary meaning.

Town. The Town of Poetry, Texas.

<u>Culvert.</u> A hollow structure of approved material, which provides waterway openings to conduct water for drainage purposes.

<u>Driveway.</u> A roadway with a defined structure that permits vehicular access between private land use(s) and public streets and alleys.

<u>Precinct Commissioner.</u> A duly elected member of the Kaufman County, Texas Commissioner's Court, or their designee or Hunt County, Texas Commissioner's Court, or their designee.

PART 3: DRIVEWAY CULVERTS REQUIRED

- (a) Driveway Culverts Required for New Construction on Town Roads: Culverts shall be installed in the Town for each driveway crossing an open existing or proposed ditch, except when the Town determines that no culvert is required. The Property Owner shall be responsible for purchase costs of any new or replacement culvert and the cost of said installation.
- (b) Permit Required for All Driveway Culverts: A permit is required for the installation of all driveway culverts. No person shall enter upon Town property or right-of-way for the purpose of laying, constructing, and/or installing any driveway culvert that disturbs the existing soil prior to receiving a permit from the Town. In determining whether to grant a permit, the Town shall review the location, size, materials, and any other installation details regarding the proposed driveway culvert. In the event that a permit is requested to replace an existing culvert due to Town construction, whether on the road or on the ditch, the Town shall waive any applicable permit fees. *Application for Culvert Installation Permit* attached as Exhibit 1.
- (c) Water to Flow at Natural Rate: Any driveway constructed on Town-Right-of- Way shall have a culvert of sufficient size to allow water to flow at its natural rate at its normal peak level, from one side of the driveway to the other, as determined by the Town.
- (d) Culvert Size: The property owner shall contact the Town to receive a minimum standard on the appropriate culvert diameter size, material type and required construction standards.
- (e) Existing Culverts: Existing culverts in good condition and not containing any blockages or other restrictions will be allowed to remain in "as-is" condition, as determined by the Town. The property owner is solely responsible for any necessary or routine maintenance, such as removing any obstructions of water flow, and repairs, including both the culvert and driveway. Existing culverts that are determined by the Town to be in less than good condition shall be subject to corrective measures, as outlined herein.

PART 4: AUTHORITY TO ABATE DEFECTIVE CULVERTS

- (a) Declared a Nuisance: It is unlawful and declared a nuisance for any person owning, claiming, occupying or having supervision or control of any real property, occupied or unoccupied, within the corporate limits of the Town, to violate any of the provisions contained herein.
- (b) Abatement by Town: To the greatest extent permitted by law, the Town reserves the right to prevent any nuisance within the corporate limits of the Town, and shall have each nuisance removed at the expense of the person who is responsible for the nuisance or who owns the property on which the nuisance exists.

PART 5: PENALTY PROVISION

Any person, firm, corporation or business entity violating or failing to comply with any provision or requirement of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall, be fined in an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for any violation involving litter, fire, safety, zoning, public health, or sanitation, and in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for all other types of violations. The Town retains all legal rights and remedies available to it pursuant to local, state and federal law.

SECTION II.

Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances: This Ordinance, upon its enactment and effective date, shall repeal all conflicting ordinances relative to conflicts of interest.

SECTION III.

Severability: Should any part, subpart, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, illegal or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Poetry hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION IV.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage and publication of the caption as the law in such cases provide.

Culvert Process Instructions

- 1) The Property Owner must place a stake to clearly mark the proposed location of the culvert.
- 2) A representative from the Town of Poetry will conduct an inspection of the marked location within 14 working days of notification to determine the necessary size of the culvert for installation.
- 3) It is the Property Owner's responsibility to ensure that their contractor installs the culvert correctly. Any improperly installed culvert, not adhering to the required grades, will be removed, and the applicant will be obligated to reinstall it at their own expense.
- 4) Acceptable materials for culverts are limited to galvanized corrugated metal or HDPE (High-Density Polyethylene) Double Wall Plastic only.
- 5) For concrete driveways only, HDPE Double Wall High-Density Polyethylene Plastic is permitted.
 - a) Concrete driveways must stop 12 inches before the county road to allow for a proper tie-in.
 - b) If ditch work or culvert replacement is needed under a concrete driveway, the Property Owner is responsible for sawing and replacing the driveway surface.
- 6) The length of any culvert must be no less than 30 feet and no more than 60 feet.
- 7) All culverts must be installed 4 inches below the ditch line, parallel to the ditch, and on the correct grade. The "ditch line" is the lowest point of a V-bottom ditch or the furthest point from the roadway of a flatbottom ditch where the roadway slopes back to the existing ground line.
- 8) Upon completion of the installation, the culvert must be covered with a minimum of 6 inches of coverage material. Acceptable coverage materials include road base, crushed concrete (procured from a crusher), gravel, asphalt, reclaimed/recycled asphalt or pour in place concrete.

- 9) The Property Owner is required to call for inspections at the completion stage of the culvert installation process.
- 10) If the inspection fails, the property owner or applicant must correct the issues within 30 days. Failure to do so will result in the removal of the culvert, which will be placed on the backside of the ditch.
